30 hour funded places in our Nursery

We are delighted to share the news that we are in the process of planning the opportunity for children to attend our school nursery for 30 hours a week. We currently only offer 15 hours for all children.

The proposal would be:

8:45am- 3:00pm

Children will bring a packed lunch to have in the nursery setting

The morning club would open up to nursery children from 8:00am for £2 a day or £9 a week

If you would need after school care for your child, Teenie Icen offer an after-school care and collect the children from school, we are also in the process of planning after school provision in the school.

If you are not entitled or do not want to take up the 30 hours in our Nursery, we will offer:

8:45-11:45am Morning nursery session

12:00-3:00pm Afternoon nursery session

Are you entitled to 30 hours?

You may be able to get 30 hours free childcare depending on the following:

- if you are working
- your income (and your partner's income, if you have one)
- your child's age and circumstances
- your immigration status

You can get 30 hours free childcare at the same time as claiming Universal Credit, Tax Credits, Childcare Vouchers or Tax-Free Childcare.

If you are working

You can usually get 30 hours free childcare if you (and your partner, if you have one) are:

- in work
- on sick leave or annual leave
- on shared parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave

If you're on adoption leave for a child aged 3 to 4 years old, you must return to work within 31 days of the date you first apply for 30 hours free childcare for that child.

Your income

You'll need to expect to earn a certain amount over the next 3 months. This is at least the [National Minimum Wage or Living Wage](#) for 16 hours a week on average.
