Uniform

With careful consideration we have made the decision to change the colour of the school uniform. The jumpers and cardigans will change from red to jade green. The decision was made mainly because we are changing from an Infant school to a primary school and we want to be recognised as a primary school. We feel that staying red will always associate the school with 'the infant school'

Our uniform will consist of:

- *White polo shirt
- *Jade green sweatshirt or cardigan
- *black/ grey trousers, skirt or pinafore
- *black tracksuit bottoms or leggings for EYFS
- * black shorts and a white t-shirt for PE

Navy book bags, navy coats and jade green forest school hoodies will be available too. On forest school days, from September, we are asking that children please wear black leggings or tracksuit bottoms with a school forest school hoodie or school sweatshirt.

Where can we purchase the new uniform?

The uniform can be purchased with embroidered logos on from Birds in Dereham. They will hold regular stalls at the school for parents to purchase.

We have researched that most of the supermarkets stock and sell jade green jumpers and cardigans at a cheaper price for those who want them.

What about the red uniform I have for my child?

We will allow a year cross over for the old and new uniform, until September 2021. This will give children the opportunity to outwear their current uniform and purchase the new colour when needed.

What about the cost?

We have considered all options and the new uniform will cost the same as the current one. After the year cross over, parents who are possibly struggling to afford the new colour uniform can ask the school or the FOSI for support to purchase the new one.
