



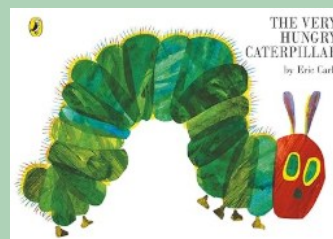
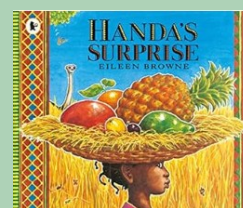
Key Learning Reception—Summer 2
