

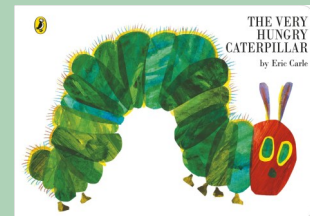


Key Learning Nursery—Summer 2 Nature Explorers
