



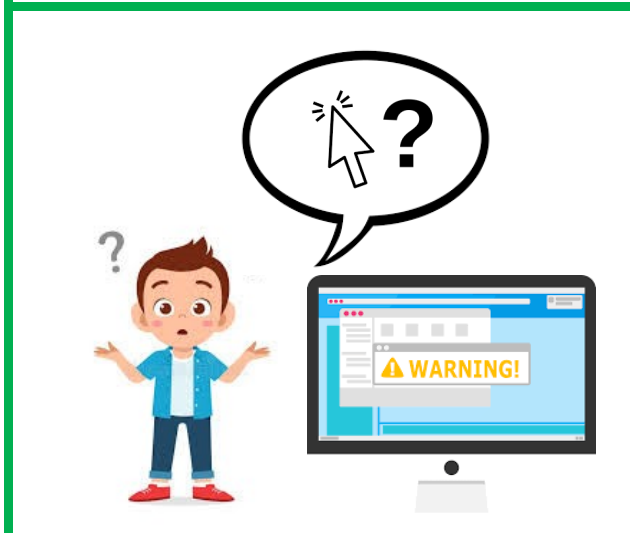
Computing Code of Conduct EYFS

Computing Code of Conduct

Key Stage 1

I will always ask a teacher or trusted adult before I use a device.

I will only open apps or programs that an adult has told me to use.

I know that I must tell an adult if I see something on a screen that makes me scared, worried, or upset.

I know that passwords are private.

I know my personal information such as my address, birthday, or location should never be shared online.

I am always Ready, Respectful, and Safe when communicating with others online.

I will respect the equipment and let an adult know if something isn't working.



Computing Code of Conduct

Key Stage 2

I will only access the devices when a trusted adult has given me permission to and is present.

I will not ask for, save, or send anything that could make others upset.

I will tell an adult if I see something that worries me, or I know is inappropriate.

I will keep my username and password secure; this includes not sharing it with others.

I understand what personal information is and will never share my own or others' personal information.

I will always use my own username and password to access the school network, TTRS, and Numbots.

I know that the school will check my files and the online sites I visit to keep myself and others safe.

I will respect the equipment and let an adult know if something isn't working.

I will use online communication tools carefully. I will let an adult know if I notice that someone who isn't approved by the teacher is messaging.

I understand if I behave negatively while using technology towards other members of the school, my parents/carers will be informed and appropriate action taken.
